ADMISSION TO FIRST YEAR / DIRECT SECOND YEAR (SEPARATE DIVISION & LATERAL ENTRY) OF THREE-YEAR FULL TIME POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSE IN MASTER OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS (MCA) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18

As per the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. XXVIII of 2015), the Competent Authority is conducting CET (MAH-MCA-CET 2017) for admission to MCA courses.

The Online applications are invited for CET for admission to **First Year / Direct Second Year (Separate Division & Lateral Entry) of Three-year full time Post Graduate Degree course in Master of Computer Applications (MCA)** in the Government, Govt. Aided, University Managed, University Departments and Unaided Institutes in the Maharashtra State.

Application form processing fees as stated below is to be paid through online system only by Credit Card/ Debit Card (RuPay/Visa/MasterCard/Maestro), Internet Banking, IMPS, Cash Cards/ Mobile Wallets for which the service charges, as per rules, shall be applicable in addition to the application form processing fees. No other mode of payment shall be permitted. This fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

Eligibility Criteria for appearing to MAH-MCA-CET 2017:

The candidate should fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

- The candidate should be an Indian National;
- Passed minimum three-year duration Bachelor's Degree awarded by University recognised by University Grants Commission or Association of Indian Universities in any discipline with at least 50% marks in *aggregate or equivalent (at least 45% in case of candidates of backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only);
- Studied Mathematics as one of the subjects at (10+2) level or at Graduate level examination;
- For Direct second year admissions, the candidate should have passed Bachelor Degree in Computer Applications or Science (Information Technology or Computer Science).

(Candidates appearing for final year of qualifying examination are also eligible to appear for CET)

*Note: Aggregate marks means the grand total of marks obtained by the candidate in subjects based on which the class declaration is made in the particular University from which the candidate is passing the qualifying examination.

Instructions for Registration for MAH-MCA-CET 2017:

- The CET shall be conducted only in the **ONLINE** mode in **multiple sessions**, if required, by Competent Authority, using standardized equi-percentile method, will be equating scores across sessions.
- The Online CET would be comprised of two online papers viz. General Aptitude (GA) and Computer Concepts (CC) of 100 marks each, with composite time of 90 minutes' duration.** Each paper shall have 25 questions.

3. **Note that the CET will have negative mark system. Each correct answer will carry 4 marks. Each wrong answer will carry 1 negative mark. Unanswered questions will carry zero marks.**
4. Aspiring candidates should note that, the tests are not disclosed to anybody else other than the candidates only during the examination. The test papers are also not shared with anybody even after the examination.
5. It is mandatory for all aspiring candidates to **Register & Confirm** the Online Application Form through candidate login by himself/herself from the place convenient to him/her at <http://www.dtemaharashtra.gov.in/mca2017>.
6. Applications sent by Post/Courier etc., will be rejected and no communication in this regard will be made.
7. It should be noted that no documents are required to be submitted at this stage. Candidates are advised to keep the necessary original documents ready for verification at the time of Document verification stage, during Centralised Admission Process (CAP).
