**Subject: Admission Reporting Centres(ARCs) for admission to First Year Under Graduate Degree Course in Pharmacy & Pharm D for the Academic Year 2017-18.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. XXVIII of 2015), the Government of Maharashtra has notified the rules of the admissions to the First and Direct Second Year of Full Time Professional Post Graduate / Undergraduate / Diploma Technical Courses (Engineering and Technology, Pharmacy, Pharm D., Architecture, Hotel Management and Catering Technology, MBA/MMS, MCA). These rules are also applicable for admissions in Government and Government Aided institutions, University Managed Institutes/University Departments vide Government Resolution of Higher & Technical Education Department No. TEM-2016/CR 473/16/TE-4 Dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2017.

The Director, Technical Education shall act as a Nodal Officer to carry out the admissions under the supervision & control of the Competent Authority. All Joint Directors of Technical Education, Regional Offices are declared as Representative of Nodal Officer at Regional Level.

The selected Government, Government Aided, University Department/ University Managed Institutes are hereby identified to work as Admission Reporting Centers for the academic year 2017-18. (List of ARC for admission to **First Year Under Graduate Degree Course in Pharmacy & Pharm D** is attached herewith).

The Director/Principal of the institute working as ARC will work as Chief Co-ordinator for the Centre. He should appoint one coordinator (from senior faculty members) and required supporting staff having computer knowledge for this activity.

**Role of Admission Reporting Centre(ARC)**

**Activity-I: Admission Reporting Activity**

- ❖ Reporting of Admission in Online Application System for CAP as per allotted in CAP Round I, II, III. Candidate should report to the ARC only on first reporting.
- ❖ Facilitate candidate, if required, for Online Updating of reporting status of candidate (Freeze/Slide/Float). Candidate should update the status through their login only.
- ❖ Verification of Original Documents, Collection of seat acceptance fee & issue of Acknowledgement/Receipt of the Reporting.
- ❖ Online cancellation of Admission, issue of acknowledgement, if applicable, as per the rules.
- ❖ Guiding and counseling to the candidates/parents.
- ❖ Keeping record of the Reporting, Cancellation and Online payment ( As acceptance fee).
- ❖ ARC can permit the candidate to change option of reporting before start of CAP Round II and III.

The Commissioner, State CET Cell, Mumbai will pay Rs.100/-(Rs. Hundred Only) per confirmation of receipt of application form after successful completion of the admission process of the respective courses. The distribution of the amounts collected under activities mentioned in above referred office order between staff involved in admission activity & Institute is given in the following Table.

**Important Instructions to ARC**

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1. ARC Coordinator shall contact to the respective Regional Offices for "how to activate their Institute as ARC through the Institute Login" and collect Instruction Manual through mail from the respective Regional Offices without fail.
2. ARC Coordinator shall collect Seat Acceptance Fees through online mode only, Rs.5000/- for Candidates of General Category, VJ/DT, NT, SBC/OBC Category and Rs.1000/- for SC, ST Category Candidates. The Candidate has to pay the Seat Acceptance Fee during First Reporting only. This fee shall be transferred to the institution after deducting Rs.1000/- towards Processing Fee.
3. Candidates who want to reject the allotted seat can do so by not remitting the seat acceptance fee at the reporting centre in scheduled period.
4. ARC Coordinator shall cancel the admission of the candidate as per request of candidate .
5. ARC shall update the reporting of the candidates with 100% accuracy. Any fault or negligence at the level of ARC will be dealt seriously. Due to fault or negligence on the part of ARC if any, candidate to lose his chance of admission, responsibility of such mistakes/omission in the process will be fixed on the person responsible for such mistakes/omissions.
6. If any ARC found involved in any form of unlawful activities like misguidance and non-cooperation to the aspiring candidates, ARC will be liable for severe action by the Competent Authority.

**The Minimum infrastructure required at ARC is as follows,**

1. Separate Network i5/i7 or of higher configuration PC for Confirmation of admission for, **UG admissions** – minimum 5 computers.
2. Windows 8 or higher Operating System with up to date security & service patches
3. Microsoft Office 2003 or higher version on all machine, Adobe Acrobat Reader 10.0 or above.
4. All machines should be connected through LAN with minimum 2 Mbps internet connectivity through ADSL/Wimax /Leased line or other devices.
5. Internet Explorer 8.0/ Mozilla Firefox 3.0, Google Chrome 2.0 or above.
6. 3 LaserJet Network Printers.(1 for each N/W)
7. Minimum 1 Scanner with 300 dpi resolution.
8. Adequate Electrical Power Backup facilities.
9. Potable Water drinking facility.
10. Separate clean Washrooms for Gents/Ladies.


All the Principals/Directors of the ARCs are hereby informed to make the required infrastructure mentioned in order under reference ready and in working condition on or before the start of working of ARC for aforesaid admissions (as per the notification for respective program).

The Joint Director, a representative of Nodal Officer, shall be Regional ARC Officer and they shall appoint Deputy Regional ARC Officers (System Analyst and above level Officer) at Regional level for coordination of aforesaid activities and communicate their contact details of officers appointed so .

Officers of Desk 3 (IT Cell) of this office shall work as Coordinator for ARC activities under the control of Nodal Officer.

The ARC Payments shall be done strictly by NEFT @Rs.100 per reporting by 20<sup>th</sup> Sept 2017.

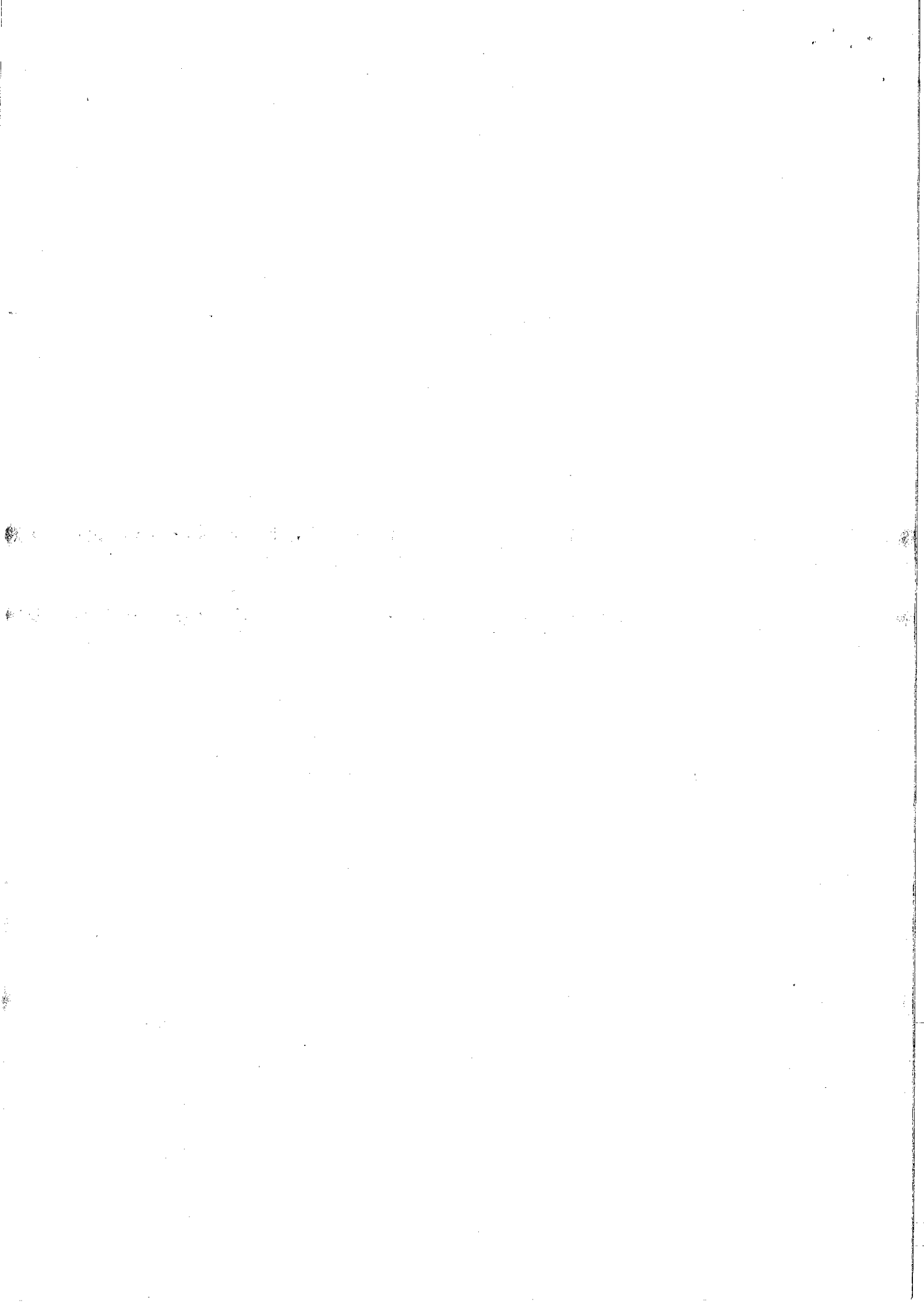

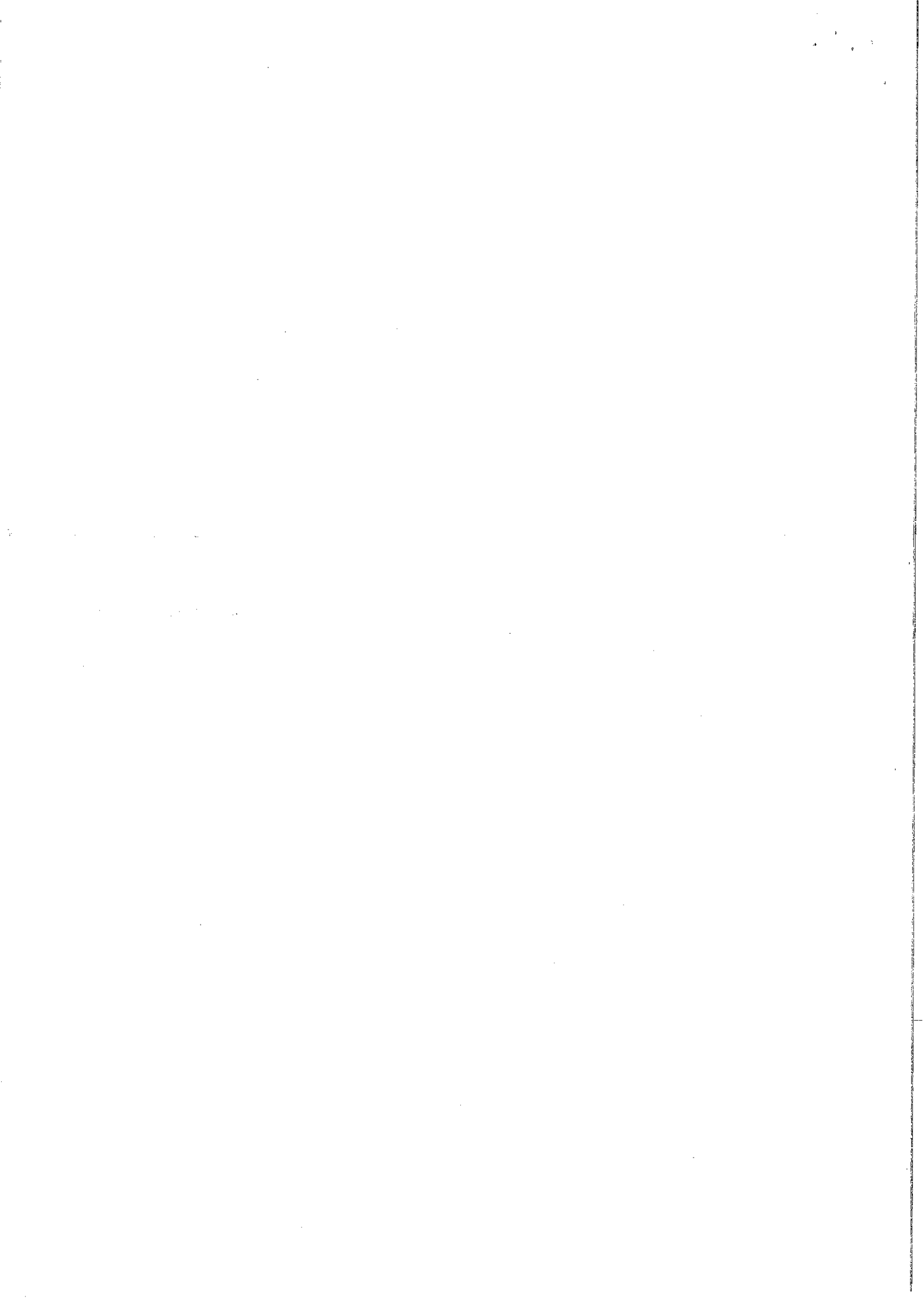
