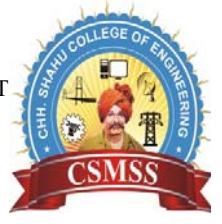

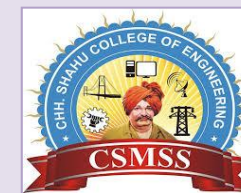

What is NPTEL?

NPTEL is an initiative by the IITs (IIT Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras and Roorkee) and IISc along with full financial support by MHRD.

The main objective of the *National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning* (NPTEL) is to enhance the quality of engineering and science education in the country by developing contents for undergraduate and postgraduate curricula using video and web based courses. These courses cover the syllabi prescribed by universities and approved by AICTE.

- The basic objective of science and engineering education in India is to devise and guide reforms that will transform India into a strong and vibrant knowledge economy. In this context, the focus areas for NPTEL project have been i) higher education, ii) professional education, iii) distance education and iv) continuous and open learning, roughly in that order of preference.
- Manpower requirement for trained engineers, scientists and technologists is far more than the number of qualified graduates that Indian educational institutions can provide currently. Among these, the number of institutions having fully qualified and trained teachers in all disciplines being taught forms a small fraction. NPTEL helps disseminate teaching/learning content of high quality and uses technology for dissemination.

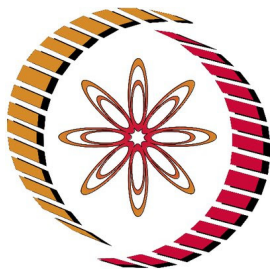

Guidelines for Colleges Hosting A One-Day NPTEL Awareness Workshop

Purpose of this document

In this document, we outline the Guidelines to be followed by Institutions hosting one-day NPTEL/NME workshops and for which funds are provided by the MHRD through IIT Madras. We have made these suggestions based on our experience with hosts in the past and the questions that have been asked.

The aim of NPTEL/NME workshops is to create maximum awareness among faculty members about the programme and implementation of technology enhanced learning in the classroom and beyond. They are also aimed at increasing the effectiveness of these lectures through feedback from participants.

NPTEL and the host Institute operate on a Shared Responsibility model. We request the host Institute to **identify one person** (with the authority to make decisions) to be the **key coordinator**. This person will interface with NPTEL's Workshop coordinator to ensure smooth organization and conduct of the workshop.

Roles & Responsibilities

What the Host Institute needs to take into account:

1. Provide the **venue with audio/visual capability** (to project from a laptop/PC)
2. Help us in publicizing the workshop in the Engineering and Technical Colleges/Institutes nearby
3. Invite **appropriate Participants**:
 - About 40-50 participants who are at the level of Principals
 - 100- 150 participants who are at the level of HoDs / faculty in Engineering (any branch) /experienced faculty at the Professor level from institutions in the region (including those from the host institute). These are not subject-specific workshops but will help enable the host and the institutions in the vicinity to implement NPTEL programme and similar ones in them. Hence senior faculty members who can help influence new electronic policies in academic decision-making are desired.
4. Communicating to all participants: We request the host college to take care of the process of communicating to the colleges nearby and confirming the list of participants. Two or three participants from each institute are desired.
5. NPTEL will assist the host institute by sharing the **Google form link** that it uses when conducting similar workshops.

What NPTEL will do

1. Prepare the Agenda
2. Prepare and conduct the Presentations
3. Coordinate the break out sessions
4. Provide contents to be included in the workshop kits.
5. Provide the workshop (re-usable) banners
6. Pay for food, workshop kit and refreshments.
7. NPTEL members will make their own travel arrangements to and from the city of the hosting college.

Costs

NPTEL will bear the expenditure related to food, workshop kit and refreshments. We request the hosts to get these **costs pre-approved** before placing the orders with the vendors. Travel by members from outside institutes will be covered at the rate of second class A/C train fare or equivalent. If taxis are engaged, receipts need to be provided as per Government norms.

Food and Refreshments: NPTEL will pay for providing lunch to all participants and for tea /coffee once during the course of the half-day workshop.

Workshop Kits

If a kit is to be handed out, it would be a plastic L-Folder. The host institution can arrange this from local vendors. The kit will contain brochures, travel reimbursement form and some stationery. NPTEL will provide the brochures, agenda, and TA reimbursement form in soft copy, which the host institution can print.

We request the host to notify the total cost of the bag and stationery (notepad and pen) and get it **pre-approved** from NPTEL.

Travel for participants: NPTEL will reimburse participants for travel from their city of residence to the city where workshop is conducted, if they are different. If TA has to be provided to outstation participants, we will provide TA up to 2ND A/C fare on production of rail tickets (**copies of both onward and return tickets are required**) by the participants.

Please Note: For one-day/half-day workshops, we **do not** reimburse participants for accommodation.

If there are any other expenses (not covered above) please get **prior approval** by sending an email to localchapter@npTEL.iitm.ac.in

Logistics for NPTEL Personnel Attending the Workshops

Typically, up to four NPTEL members (presenters and organizers) will be arriving on the day of the workshop.

We look forward to having a joint workshop that is mutually beneficial.

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES

- Soft copy of TA form will be mailed from NPTEL office, IIT Madras. Copies need to be made and added to the workshop kit.

NOTE:

- ❖ **Without travel tickets, reimbursement will not be done. Please ensure to enclose travel ticket along with TA form for all participants and delegates while reimbursing.**
- ❖ **Please settle the TA for all participants at the end of the workshop.**
- ❖ Carefully go through the TA rules and regulations. Please have one person from your Institute Accounts section to be present at the workshop to take care of the accounts.
- ❖ The expenditure statement, as given in the guidelines, should be prepared and submitted to the NPTEL accounts for settling the accounts.
- ❖ Please have TA reimbursement ready while reimbursing the TA claims of the participants.

Travel Reimbursement Rules:

1. **Travel fare will be *reimbursed* only with the submission of tickets. This is mandatory.**
2. **Original onward train ticket/ bus ticket/ Taxi fare ticket and photocopy of return ticket should be provided for travel reimbursement.**
3. Travel allowance for all participants will be reimbursed towards the end of the workshop.
4. Only round trip fare from the participant's institution to your institution will be reimbursed. Maximum permissible distance (one way) for reimbursement is 100km (unless prior approval is sought from the concerned IIT/IISc).

Bus travel:

For local participants, bus fare from/to city will be reimbursed.

Using personal car:

Participants traveling by their own car should remit a copy of their RC book and should declare the distance travelled. They will be paid **Rs 12/km**.

Using Travel Cab

The original bill as charged by the travel services should be submitted for reimbursement.

Travel by Train

For those traveling by train, the reimbursement will be equivalent to the **II A/C train fares** from the participant's city to the city of the host institute.

Local Conveyance

Local conveyance (railway/bus station to venue of workshop) will be reimbursed only on production of taxi/auto receipt.

The TA forms (along with all the tickets/bills submitted) should be sent to the NPTEL office. Each TA form should be signed by the concerned participant and the organizing institute.
